TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR TFS: YOUR IN TO TIFF CONTEST

1. Contest Name:

- "TFS: Your In to TIFF"

2. Organizer:

- Yorkville Education Company, operating as Toronto Film School

3. Affiliations

- "Your in to TIFF" contest and giveaway is not sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with Toronto International Film Festival®.

6. Eligibility Requirements:

- Participants must be 18 years old or older.
- Participants must be residents of Canada.
- Open to individuals considering enrollment with Toronto Film School, as well as current students and alumni of Toronto Film School.

7. Entry Method:

The contest happens in two separate streams, with two different entry pathways & audiences.

- **For Prospective Students:**

- Entrant must submit full application to Toronto Film School by August 22, 2024, for an October 2024 Start.
- By submitting the application, the entrant is automatically entered for a chance to win.
- Only applications to Toronto Film School on-campus programs are eligible.
- Winners must start their program in October 2024.

Toronto Film School

- **For Current Students and Alumni:**

- Entrant must submit a 1-minute video introducing themselves and their motivation to attend TIFF 2024, addressing "Why them? Why now?" in the video.
- Optionally, entrant should submit a short film of theirs, live action or animation, that they have either written, produced, directed, or starred in, that they would love to see screened at TIFF on Festival Street.
- Submission deadline: August 22
- Videos should be submitted as preview links (unlisted and/or private if preferred), not as actual files (no upload functionality available).
- Both live action and animated shorts are welcome.
- Entrants are responsible for clearing all rights and permissions for the short film to be screened September 5-8, 2024, on TIFF's Festival Street.
- Submission deadline: August 15, 2024.

- i. **Qualification:**

- Must be an active student or a graduate of Toronto Film School.
- Entrants with both a strong motivational video and a short film submission will be considered first.
- It is possible to win a pass without a short film, or to have a short film screened without winning a pass.
- All Conference Pass winners will attend TIFF as TFS social media ambassadors, with mandated content expectations.

8. Releases:

- By submitting the short film videos, the Entrant consents to the videos being displayed at TIFF Festival Street, between September 5-8, 2024. The Organizer will not display or use the submissions anywhere else without the Entrant's consent.
- It is the responsibility of the winner to ensure that they do not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person and must not violate any law. The Organizer is exempt from any such responsibility.

9. Contest Period:

- The contest runs from July 29, 2024, to August 29, 2024.
- Submission deadline: August 22, 2024
- Winners announced: August 29, 2024

10. Prizes:

- 15 Conference Passes to TIFF, each valued at CAD \$570+, distributed as follows:
 - 5 Conference Passes awarded to 5 prospects who have submitted their full application by August 22nd, 2024, for an October 2024 start – chosen via a draw.
 - 10 Conference Passes awarded to students and alumni who have submitted a strong motivational video and (optional) a short film to be screened at the Festival Street by August 22nd– selected on a merit base by The Organizer.
- The chance to have your short film screened on Festival Street during the first 4 days of the festival – only applicable for current students & alumni Entrants who have submitted their short films. A total of 30 best short films will be selected for screening.
- The Winner is solely responsible for all expenses, costs or fees associated with transportation and acceptance and/or use of the prize not specified herein as being awarded, including without limitation, any and all taxes (if any). Winner is not a recipient of a prize until they have been verified as the Winner by the Organizer. Upon fulfilling prize, the Organizer will be deemed to have awarded the prize to the Winner and such Winner assumes full responsibility for the prize. All prize details are at the Organizer's sole discretion.
- Entrants acknowledge that transportation, if applicable, is not included in the prize and that any events are beyond the control of the Organizer and are subject to being rescheduled, modified or cancelled. In that event, the Organizer reserves the right to, at its discretion, reschedule the Contest, entry and/or end dates, modify the entry procedures, cancel the Contest, or cancel the awarding of ticket(s). Prize(s) are not redeemable for cash.

11. Judging Criteria:

- Prospective students' applications are automatically entered into a draw for 5 Conference Passes.
- Current students and alumni must submit a motivational video for a chance to win one of 10 Conference Passes.
- Short film submissions are considered a bonus.
- Winners will be chosen based on the strength of motivation and the quality of the short film (if applicable).

12. Notification of Winners:

- Winners will be announced on or after August 29, 2024, via email.
